NZ Scholarship

NZ Scholarship Awards recognise excellence for secondary school students. It is used to determine top scholars and allocate monetary awards.

- You attempt NZ Scholarship by sitting an exam, or by submitting a portfolio/report for the following subjects - Design and Visual Communication, Physical Education, Technology and Visual Arts.
- Scholarship exams are based on the Level 3 work you have done, although the questions will be very different and the standard of work required will be at a very advanced level.
- NZ Scholarship exams can only be sat in New Zealand exam venues.
- There is a separate exam for each subject area.
- The entry fee for each NZ Scholarship subject is \$30.00. This is in addition to the NCEA fee.
- NZ Scholarship does not attract credits for NCEA or contribute towards a qualification. Therefore, it does not contribute towards Entrance to University requirements.
- All NZ Scholarship awards will be recorded on the candidate's Record of Achievement.
