<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Internal assessments can continue to be sent in after 11 Nov up until the end of January. Assessments received by Te Kura during this time should have a covering note for the teacher to ask for it to be marked so it counts for your 2016 school year. These results will be included in your 2016 NZQA records but may only appear in your Record of Achievement from March 2017 after these late results have been finalised with NZQA.
