Internal assessment deadline

Your internal work for NCEA assessment should reach Te Kura as soon as possible before **10 November 2017** to ensure your 2017 results are available in your Record of Achievement in mid-January 2018.

You can continue to send in work for internal assessment up until the end of January 2018 and any NCEA results can still count towards your 2017 school year if you include a note alerting your teacher. These results will be available in your Record of Achievement in early March 2018.

Special Assessment Conditions (SAC)

Students with specific physical, medical, sensory or learning disabilities may be approved for special assessment conditions (SAC) for internal and external NCEA assessments. If you think you might need SAC, please check out our website - www.tekura.school.nz/sac.
