

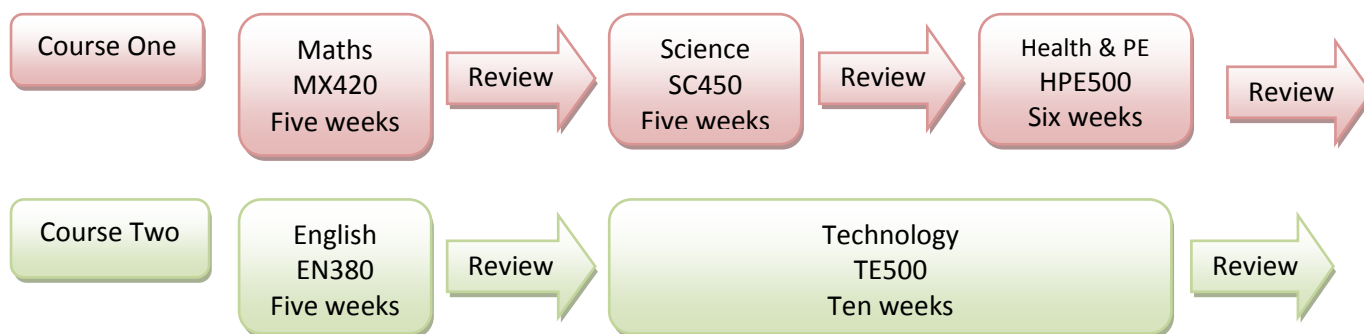

Choosing a programme

Regular courses may suit. However, by engaging with selected modules of learning within courses, students can engage with a range of curriculum areas over time, for example:



Modules can relate to specific topics of need and/or interest to the student, to specific achievement opportunities, or to a generalised experience as a foundation to further learning. The student sets goals within each module. These are reviewed at the end of an agreed period of time. Goals might link to attendance, organisational skill building, willingness to engage, topic completion, effort, achievement, use of resources to support learning, building capacity to manage on-task capability and using strategies to target specific behaviour/learning barriers.
