

Digital End of Year Exam Checklist

A digital end of year exam is sat online on your laptop at your approved exam centre. Your confirmation email will tell you if your exam will be sat digitally.

If you are sitting any digital exams, these checks below are essential. **Have you:**

Created your NZQA learner login account? **If not:**

1. Go to www2.nzqa.govt.nz/login/create-account/
2. If you don't know your NSN, just ask your kaimanaaki

Memorised your NZQA learner login username and password? This is how you will access your digital exam standards on exam day/s.

Practiced logging in to your NZQA learner login account?

On exam day/s, remember to take:

- Your **fully charged laptop** (or device with a physically attached keyboard)
- Headphones** (compatible with your laptop) if you are sitting a Language listening standard
- Laptop **charging cord** or power bank
- Mouse** (if you need one)
- Pens** (black or blue) to take notes or just in case you need to switch to paper due to technical issues
- Exam admission slip** (posted to you in late October)
- Photo ID**
