

Here are some things people have found out about sharks.




Sharks swim with their mouths open.

Sharks do not have bones.


Sharks have more than one row of teeth.





- Circle the words you think tell about or describe sharks' teeth.




Activity 3 | Hei mahi 3

- 5. People are more likely to be killed by wasp stings or lightning than by sharks.




Activity 5 | Hei mahi 5

I will read and talk about teeth facts.




They bite, tear and chew food.
